CDMENU, Version 2.0

Due to a manufacturing production error, the CDMENU utility located in the [CDROM] directory on discs 2 through 12 contains an error in the product installation function. The CDMENU.EXE file on disc 1 of 12 contains the corrected version.

Problem Description

When using CDMENU to perform product installations via Option 6 of the main menu, an incorrect save set name is used in the VMSINSTAL command line. This problem occurs only when more than one (1) VMSINSTAL kit is contained in the [.kit] directory or if the VMSINSTAL kit name is not the same as the products root directory. This problem affects no other option under CDMENU.

Solution

A corrected CDMENU, V2.1, has been placed in the [CDROM] directory of disc 1 of the OpenVMS VAX Consolidated Software Distribution. You have the following solutions available to you:

1. Copy the new CDMENU V2.1 executable file to your hard disk and run it from there rather than from the CD_DIRECTORY logical. So, if you copied CDMENU to SYS\$MANAGER, you would run CDMENU using the following command:

```
$ RUN SYS$MANAGER:CDMENU
```

2. Always mount disc 1 of the set and specify it first in the CD_DIRECTORY logical. For example, you mount disc 1 on DKA500 and disc 4 on DKA500. The logical definition for CD_DIRECTORY would then be:

```
$ DEFINE CD_DIRECTORY DKA500:[CDROM],DKA500:[CDROM]
```

3. Perform VMSINSTAL for products containing more than one kit from the DCL command line.
